<p>Nomination deadlines</p>	<p>Until May 15th for the first/fall semester or full year Until October 31st for the second/spring semester</p>
<p>Specifications</p>	<p>We welcome both undergraduate and graduate students under bilateral agreements or from non-EU partner institutions, depending on departmental availability. Some Master's (Year 1 and Year 2) courses may not be open to exchange students. All academic fields are generally open, except for the Medicine department, unless otherwise specified in the agreement.</p> <p>For Erasmus students, please verify the current interinstitutional agreement. The main nominated field should remain the student's primary study area, and most courses must be taken within that field. Courses from other departments may be allowed with prior approval from the pedagogical coordinator of the secondary field.</p>
<p>Number of students</p>	<p>It depends on the agreement signed between our universities.</p>
<p>Language requirements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • B1 level in French is required and a B2 level is highly recommended. We accept official certificates (DELF, DALF, TCF, TEF, etc.) as well as certificates issued by your university's language center. • DELF Diploma: https://www.france-education-international.fr/diplome/delf-tout-public • TCF test certificate: https://www.france-education-international.fr/test/tcf-tout-public <p>Please note that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exchange students who are native speakers are exempt from submitting proof of language proficiency. • Exchange students participating in the International Business Program (IBP) are not required to provide evidence of French language proficiency. • Within the Faculty of LLSHS, non-Erasmus students are required to demonstrate adequate proficiency in the French language: a minimum level of B1 (with a DELF Diploma mandatory) for Licence (Undergraduate) programmes and a minimum level of B2 (with a DELF Diploma mandatory) for Master's (Graduate) programmes, in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). • Depending on individual circumstances, non-Erasmus applicants may also be invited to attend a video conference interview with a professor from the Faculty of LLSHS as part of the admission process.
<p>Preparatory language courses</p>	<p>An intensive French week (18 hours) is organized at the beginning of each semester. Students are placed into groups according to their proficiency level (A2 to C1, in accordance with the CEFR*) following a placement test. USPN also offers French language courses throughout both semesters.</p>

<p>Credits/ECTS</p>	<p>The number of ECTS required to validate the mobility will be determined by the sending institution and the student on their Learning Agreement.</p> <p>Please note that an Erasmus student can earn a maximum of 30 ECTS per semester and 60 ECTS per year.</p>
<p>Application</p>	<p>The students will receive a MoveOn Application Form in order to apply as soon as the home university will nominate them by email to: incoming@univ-paris13.fr</p> <p>While nominating please indicate your student's: Name - Surname - Nationality - Date of birth- Email - Field of study (with ISCED Code) - Semester</p>
<p>Documents required for upload on the MoveOn platform</p>	<p>Learning agreement, official transcripts of academic records, statement of purpose, letter of recommendation from the course leader, a proof of French proficiency, Curriculum Vitae, copy of passport, student card from your university.</p> <p>Please note that the Online Learning Agreement will be signed once the student's application is finalized and accepted.</p>

<p>Orientation</p>	<p>A welcome week is organized at the beginning of each semester for exchange students, followed by intensive French classes and various social activities. We also encourage interaction between international and French students to help international students build connections and find support during their stay.</p>

<p>Accommodation</p>	<p>To be able to benefit from accomodation, the student must indicate on the MoveOn Application Form their wish to have a Crous room.</p> <p>Crous Créteil allocates rooms according to their available spaces. Between 390€ and 500€.</p>
<p>Insurance</p>	<p>Exchange students will have to be insured (accident, disease, civil responsibility). Students under 28 have to subscribe to the student social security (free of charge).</p>

<p>Visa requirements</p>	<p>Type-D student visa. Please note that students must register with Etudes En France - Campus France office (online application process: https://pastel.diplomatie.gouv.fr/etudesenfrance/dyn/public/authentication/login.html) to apply for admission and obtain a visa.</p> <p>Either they register in the website “Etudes en France” with our letter of acceptance; section “je suis accepté” or they will automatically receive an email from this application when they are accepted and nominated by us in this application.</p>
<p>Cost of living</p>	<p>About 800 € per month.</p>
<p>Registration</p>	<p>USPN uses a dematerialized process: students will get access to our platforms after they are nominated and accepted.</p>
